## Registration

## T-Shirts and Hats

All campers who register for a minimum of one weekly session will receive a free t-shirt and bucket hat. These are helpful to identify the children in large groups when out on day trips. We ask Campers to wear the hats daily and t-shirts on trip days.

Additional T-shirts and hats can also be purchased for \$10 each or \$15 for the set.

## Payment Policy

- Upon registration, payment must be made by post-dated cheque (or cash two weeks prior to the camp start date). If registration occurs within two weeks of the camp start date the payment must be dated on the registration date.
- A \$15 fee will be charged for any returned cheques

When you register your child for summer camp a Consent Form will be given to you for permission for the following:

- **Photo Release**  
During the camp we will take photos of the children and staff for use in our brochures and promotional material.
- **Sunscreen**  
Please send your child with their own **fragrance free** sunscreen labelled with their full name.
- **Field Trips**  
There will be a weekly field trip.
- **Behaviour Policy**  
The Brighton Children's Centre provides a healthy, safe environment for all campers. Our aim is to work with the children to teach values of respect, honesty, caring and responsibility. Children are expected to follow the behaviour guidelines.

If you need care before and after these hours this service is available at an extra cost.

## Absent Camper

Please call the centre at 613-475-1811 and leave a message for the Staff if your child will not be attending camp on any given day. Remember there is no Camp on July 1 and August 3. No refund or credit will be given for days missed.

## Food

The centre will provide all campers with nutritional snacks and lunches daily. Please check the parent bulletin board at the centre for the weekly menu plan.

## Allergy Protection Procedures

We will make every reasonable attempt to eliminate the presence of nuts and nut products within our camp program in order to minimize threats to individuals with allergies.

Your assistance is appreciated. If you or your child have consumed any nut products before arrival, we ask that you wash your hands and face etc. and brush your teeth before coming to the camp program.

## Administering Medicines

The Camp Blaze Supervisor will only administer **prescription drugs** in accordance with our medication policy. It must be in the original container with the child's name, correct dosage and storage instructions listed. Please complete a medication form if your child requires medication while attending Camp. We will not administer non-prescription medication of any kind.

## Fragrance Free Policy

Due to health concerns arising from exposure to scented products, we are committed to providing a fragrance free environment. Please refrain from using any scented products while visiting or attending Camp Blaze.

### Trained Educators

Our program supervisor and staff are experienced year-round, full time educators with a background in "Early Childhood Education" or an equivalent degree. Staff regularly attend workshops and courses to upgrade skills and all staff and volunteers must undergo a Criminal Reference Check and a security check through the Children's Aid Society as a condition of employment.
